NATIONAL ICE SKATING CHAMPIONSHIPS

27-29 APRIL 2026
JAKARTA-INDONESIA

1. GENERAL REGULATIONS

Indonesia National Ice Skating Championships 2026 is the premier annual national ice skating event in Indonesia, featuring competitions in Figure Skating and Short Track Speed Skating. The Indonesia National Figure Skating Championship 2026 will be held from **27–29 April 2026** and is conducted as an Open International Competition, welcoming participation from both Indonesian and international skaters.

While international athletes are eligible to compete, national titles are awarded exclusively to Indonesian skaters. The top three (3) Indonesian skaters in each category will be crowned Indonesia National Champions, receiving official national titles and national championship medals. In addition, combined categories that include both Indonesian and international skaters will also award medals based on overall results, recognizing podium finishers regardless of nationality. This dual-award structure ensures the integrity of the national championship while providing athletes with valuable international competitive exposure.

The Indonesia National Ice Skating Championships 2026 represents a key milestone in the national sporting calendar, reinforcing Indonesia's commitment to athlete development, competitive excellence, and international engagement in ice skating.

2. VENUE

Venue: Oasis Centre Arena (OCA) Ice Rink

AEON Mall, 1st Fl., Jakarta Garden City, Cakung, Jakarta - Indonesia

(an indoor ice-rink with the ice surface of 60 x 30 m, air-conditioned)

STARTING ORDER - DRAW

Rule 512 Draws

The draws for the starting order of all Segments are made publicly by the Referee. The Referee should ask the Organizing Committee to check the correct spelling of the names of the Competitors and Officials. Starting numbers shall be drawn by each Competitor, if present, by official representatives of their ISU Member or by members of the Organizing Committee. The official announcement of the entries and of the panels of Officials is made by the Referee of each competition at the time of the first starting order draw of that competition. Draw schedule for: Basic Level Categories, Novices, Juniors, Seniors - Will be published after final entry

3. GENERAL REGULATIONS

The 2026 Indonesia National Ice Skating Championship – Figure Skating will be conducted in accordance with the:

- ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2024;
- ISU Special Regulations and Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2024
- All pertinent ISU Communications, FISU Communications and this Announcement.

4. ELIBIGILITY

- A. Skaters seeking to compete in the Championships, other than as a Guest Skater (refer to paragraph 4.1) must be a financial member of FISU.
- B. Skaters seeking to compete in the Championships, other than as a Guest Skater (refer to paragraph 4.1) must have passed the required FISU qualifying test for the Championship level competing in prior to the commencement of the Championships
- C. Additionally, skaters must meet the eligibility conditions specified in the respective category stated herein.

4.1 DEFINITION OF GUEST SKATERS

- A Guest Skater is one who EITHER
 - a. Is not an Indonesia Citizen OR
 - b. Is an Indonesia Permanent Resident who has not obtained an official ISU clearance certificate granting him/her permission to represent Indonesia in international competitions and ISU Championships.
- A Guest Skater who places in the top position will only be given the appropriate medal but cannot hold the title of National Champion. Indonesia National Champion is only awarded to an Indonesia Citizen or Indonesia Permanent Resident who has officially obtained an ISU clearance certificate.

5. ENTRIES

All competitors must be entered **through their respective FISU Pengprov / ISU Member Federation** through the link provided: <https://bit.ly/inisc26fs> by **Monday, 23 March 2026.**

Other required documents for the participant that need to be submitted with their official entry form:

- **For Indonesia Citizen** – A certified true copy of the skater's birth certificate or passport. Skaters whose training location is not in Indonesia must also complete FISU Notice and Declaration Form.
- **For Indonesia Permanent Resident** – A certified true copy of the skater's Indonesia permanent residence permit, passport and certified true copy of an already issued ISU Clearance Certificate, allowing the skater to represent Indonesia internationally.
Please refer to FISU Notice and Declaration Form on the requirements for ISU Clearance Certificate.
- **For Guest Skater** – Entry form must be endorsed by the association of the country of his/her country of citizenship. Guest skaters who are unable to obtain such endorsement because he/she does not belong to any skating association in the country of his/her citizenship must complete the form in FISU Notice and Declaration Form.

5.1 ENTRIES OF TEAM OFFICIALS

Official entries of Team Leaders, Assistant Team Leaders, Team Medical Staff, Coaches and Chaperones must be made via email to info@iceskatingindonesia.com. Accreditation will be provided to those who are officially accepted by the Organizer. Please be advised that only one (1) Coach per Skater will be accredited. An Assistant Team Leader will be accepted for Teams having six (6) and more Skaters. Not more than one (1) Team Doctor and one (1) Team Physiotherapist will be accepted as the Team Medical Staff, for which the organizer requests the right to have a medical certification (document) presented before accreditation.

6. ENTRY FEE

With the entry to the competition, the entry fee must be paid as follows:

- USD 225 Basic Starlet, Starlet, Preliminary, Elementary, and Adult Categories
- USD 250 Basic Novice, Intermediate Novice
- USD 300 Advanced Novice, Junior & Senior

The entry fee is non-refundable in the event of withdrawal for any reason.

After the Final Entry deadline **Monday, 23 March 2026 at 18:00 (GMT+7), Jakarta time**, the respective ISU Member Federations will receive an invoice for the entry fee(s).

The entry fee(s) shall be paid within three (3) days after receipt of the invoice. Entries for which payment has not been received within this period shall be automatically cancelled.

In any case, all entry fee(s) must be paid no later than **Thursday, 26 March 2026 at 18:00 (GMT+7), Jakarta time**, by bank transfer to the following account:

Any late payments after the deadline will incur a USD 100 late payment fee.

7. MUSIC / PLANED PROGRAM CONTENT

In accordance with Rule 343 in the ISU Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance, the following method to submit the Competitor's music to the Organizing Committee must be followed:

- All Competitors shall furnish competition music of excellent quality on mp3 format by sending separately the music file to music@iceskatingindonesia.com until **Monday, 23 March 2026**. Any other format is not acceptable.
- The title of the file must show the Nation, Competition event, Competitor's name, and the exact running time of the music (not skating time) including any starting signal.
Example: INA_Men_SP_Jason-Russel_2:48
- Each Competitor must have an own back-up music (Phone or USB Stick) for each program in the format of MP3 file. CDs will not be accepted.

- During the 1st Official Practice, the music will be played as indicated in the Practice Schedule and will allow to verify the correctness of the submitted music. If there is an issue with the music, the Team Leader/Coach may be allowed to change the music by presenting an acceptable reproduction to the Organizing Committee's Music Team (Phone or USB Stick with file format_MP3_file).

The titles, composers, and orchestras of the music to be used for the Short Program / Rhythm Dance and Free Skating / Free Dance Program must be listed for each Competitor on the dedicated ISU platform. The Planned Program Content must also be entered by the ISU Member or the Skater(s) on the dedicated ISU platform. It is mandatory that the Program Content information be filled in precisely by each Skater/team in English using the terminology for the elements listed in the respective ISU Communication. If music information is not complete and/or the music is not provided, accreditation will not be given.

All participants are required to present their **original passport** upon accreditation. Accreditation times are **subject to change**. Any changes will be communicated to the respective **Team Leaders** in due course.

10. INSURANCE / LIABILITY

In accordance with Rule 119, it is the sole responsibility of each Member participating in the Indonesia National Ice Skating Championships 2026, to provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes, officials and all other members of the Member's team. Such insurance must assure full medical attendance and the return of the ill or injured person to the home country by air transport or by other expeditious means. It is an internal matter of each ISU Member to decide the issue who shall pay the premium for such insurance. The Organizer assumes no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage in connection incurred by Competitors and Officials. The medical emergency service will be present at the ice-rink during the Competition.

11. PERSONAL DATA PROTECTION (PDPA)

By entering the competition, all participants agree that their personal data will be collected by the **Organizing Committee (OC)** and stored and processed by the OC and, where necessary, by third parties, **solely for the purposes of and to the extent necessary to facilitate participation in the competition.**

Personal data may include, but shall not be limited to, **full legal name as stated in national identity documents, address, date of birth, nationality, and gender.**

12. RESULTS

The marking system (ISU Judging System) as described in ISU Technical Rule Single & Pair Skating, Rule 352 and Rule 353 (Determination and publication of results) will be used.

13. PRESENTATION OF MEDALS

While international athletes are eligible to compete, national titles are awarded exclusively to Indonesian skaters. The top three (3) Indonesian skaters in each category will be crowned Indonesia National Champions, receiving official national titles and national championship medals. In addition, combined categories that include both Indonesian and international skaters will also award medals based on overall results, recognizing podium finishers regardless of nationality. The three (3) best placed skaters in each event will be announced and honoured. Gold, silver and bronze medals will be presented to the medallists from all categories. All participants will receive a certificate with their placement. This dual-award structure ensures the integrity of the national championship while providing athletes with valuable international competitive exposure.
