**Clarification on Junior Category Technical Requirements -
Indonesia National Ice Skating Championships 2026**

The Organizing Committee of the Indonesia National Ice Skating Championship 2026 would like to clarify the technical requirements for the Junior Category.

In the initial announcement, it was stated that the Junior Category would follow the ISU Season 2026–2027 requirements. After further review, it has been determined that the competition will instead **follow the current ISU Season 2025–2026 requirements**.

This adjustment is necessary because the base value for the Choreographic Spin / Choreographic Sequence element for Season 2026–2027 has not yet been officially published in the ISU Scale of Values (SOV). The updated SOV is typically released through an ISU Communication prior to July 1 of the new season, usually between May and June 2026.

Therefore, to ensure fair and accurate judging using officially published values, the **Junior Category at the Indonesia National Ice Skating Championship 2026 will follow the current season (2025–2026) ISU technical requirements**. Please see Appendix 1 for the technical requirements.

We sincerely apologize for any confusion this may have caused and appreciate the understanding of all athletes, coaches, and officials.

Further updates will be communicated if necessary.

APPENDIX 1:

The Junior Short Program shall consist of the following required elements:

2025-2026

Men

- a) Double or triple Axel Paulsen;
- b) Double or triple Loop jump;
- c) Jump combination consisting of a double and a triple jump or two triple jumps;
- d) Flying sit spin;
- e) Camel spin with only one change of foot;
- f) Spin combination with only one change of foot;
- g) Step sequence fully utilizing the ice surface.

Women

- a) Double Axel Paulsen;
- b) Double or triple Loop jump;
- c) Jump combination consisting of two double jumps or one double and one triple jump or two triple jumps;
- d) Flying sit spin;
- e) Layback / sideways leaning spin or camel spin without change of foot;
- f) Spin combination with only one change of foot;
- g) Step sequence fully utilizing the ice surface.

Junior Well-Balanced Program

A well-balanced Free Skating program for Men must contain:

- maximum of seven jump elements (one of which must be an Axel type jump);
- maximum of three spins, one of which must be a spin combination,
- one a flying spin or a spin with a flying entrance and one a spin with only one position;
- maximum of one choreographic sequence.

A well-balanced Free Skating program for Women must contain:

- maximum of seven jump elements (one of which must be an Axel type jump);
- maximum of three spins, one of which must be a spin combination,
- one a flying spin or a spin with a flying entrance and one a spin with only one position;
- maximum of one choreographic sequence.
